#### FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

Name Tags are no longer a requirement in our park, however, it makes it easier to remember your fellow Desert Shadowians, so, if you still have your name badge I encourage you to wear them. If you are interested in purchasing a magnetic name badge, they are \$7.50 and can be ordered in the Activities Office.

We have (4) four dog run areas for you to take your pets to for them to "take care of business" and run around. There is also a "Dog Park" on W. Utopia Road and N. 19th Ave. If you head east on Union Hills and take a left onto 19th Ave. it will be on the left hand side of the street at Utopia Rd. If you get to the 101 you went to far.

The Trash Dumpster is located by the back gate. The two green dumpsters near the Mailboxes are for Recyclables ONLY. (However not everything that can be recycled may go in the Dumpsters). Here is a list of the materials that can go in these dumpsters: #1 and #2 plastics (no lids, lids are a #5), cardboard, magazines, junk mail and other paper (except tissue paper and shredded paper), Aluminum and tin cans, milk cartons and drink boxes.

Please remember to rinse out these items before recycling. Also NO pizza boxes, NO plastic bags, glass, Styrofoam or yard waste. If you bring your recyclables in a plastic bag, please empty the plastic bag out. DO NOT THROW IT IN THE RECYCABLE DUMPSTER! Thanks you!
