## **Desert Shadows Rules:**

In addition to the main park rules, some new rules have been added effective 3/1/22.

- —All full slide park models must leave Desert Shadows when sold.
- —No construction projects may be started between January 1<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup> that take longer than 7 days to complete.
- —No on-street parking (day or night) allowed on B and Q street between Dec. 1st to April 1<sup>st</sup> (this rule will become effective December 2022).
- —Tenants must clean up dog droppings on a daily basis.
- —Additional rules to come regarding number and type of vehicles/trailers/ motorcycles, etc.
