- No construction projects may be started between January 1<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup> that take longer than 7 days to complete.
- No on-street parking (day or night) allowed on B and Q street between Dec. 1st to April 1<sup>st</sup> (this rule will become effective December 2022).
- Tenants must clean up dog droppings on a daily basis.
- All vehicles must be registered with office.
- Additional rules to come regarding number and type of vehicles/trailers/ motor- cycles, golf carts, etc.
