Letter From The Editor

DOGS: We have four dog run areas you can take your pets to for them to "take care of business" and run around. Please pick up after them and throw it in trash/bucket by the gate. Also, when walking in the resort, you <u>must</u> pick up after them and dispose of bags properly. There is also a "Dog Park" on W. Utopia Road and N. 19th Ave. If you head east on Union Hills and take a left onto 19th Ave. it will be on the left hand side of the street at Utopia Rd. If you get to the 101 you went to far.

DUMPSTER: Please refrain from dumping/dropping off your garbage and unwanted items on the wall by the garbage dumpster. Leaving those items draws Non-Resident individuals into our resort. If the Dumpster is gone due to Waste Management picking it up for dumping please wait until it returns to dump your bagged trash.

Your unwanted items can be dropped off at Savers at 35th Ave and Bell and the closest Goodwill is located at 19th Ave and Union Hills. Also, NO construction debris (toilets, cabinets, drywall, etc.) or furniture is allowed in dumpsters. If you are remodeling your home, you must take all debris to the dump. The dump is North on I17 and you get off oat Dixileta. Thank you, we appreciate your Cooperation.

RULES: In addition to the main resort rules, some new rules have been added effective 3/1/22.

- No construction projects may be started between January 1st and April 1st that take longer than 7 days to complete.
- No on-street parking (day or night) allowed on B and Q street between Dec. 1st to April 1st (this rule will become effective December 2022). Check with office for special circumstances.
- Tenants must clean up dog droppings on a daily basis.
- All vehicles must be registered with office.
- Additional rules to come regarding number and type of vehicles, trailers, motor-cycles, golf carts, etc.
